This weekend is known as Good Shepherd weekend, and that runs with the World Day of Prayer for vocations. This is an opportunity for all to pray for Vocations to the Priesthood and Consecrated Life. We pray for those discerning their vocation, especially those in our diocese, that they may be open to hear and respond to the Lord's call.

There is a lot of talk of "the call" when you run in evangelisation, so it is not something with which I am unfamiliar. But that doesn't mean it easy to understand. What does that look like for the average Catholic person?

I can not speak to a call to consecrated life but I can speak of what the call has looked like for me in my vocation as wife, mother, and lay parish worker. For me, to discern the vocation of marriage, was a simple one. I had always wanted to be a wife and mother, as a little girl dressing up in whatever I could find to be a veil and pretend to get married, putting rings on my finger to see how it would look, playing with the baby dolls like they were my children. Looking back, I can see clearly that this was something that was always on my heart and I was destined for this purpose. The call to this job may look like it is something that I stumbled into, but I felt called to be here, right place, right time, a life pointing me in this direction, my roots firmly in place here over 30 years. The words came out of my mouth that "I feel called but not equipped" Fr Michael assured me that becoming equipped will come with time, but being called is the important part.

And that is true! Hearing God's call over your life *is* the important part. No one who follows the call feels equipped. Mary was frightened, Joseph was apprehensive, the disciples had no idea what was going on most of the time. I didn't know what to expect from being married. I certainly felt anxious about motherhood and that all worked out and I have gotten more equipped on the way. As we all do. Nothing can prepare us for the future but knowing that you are following God's guidance as He shepherds us, that is solid ground that you can build on!

First Reading: Acts of the Apostles 4:8-12: This is the only name by which we can be saved.

Second Reading: 1 John 3:1-2 We shall see God as he is.

Gospel: Jn 10:11-18: The good shepherd lays down his life for his sheep. Pray this week that we can set time to hear God's call for our lives.
